Beach of Dreams Abergele – Between the Mountains and the Sea

Beach of Dreams is run by Kinetica, and funded by Arts Council England and Historic England. It is a UK-wide Coastal Arts Festival that aims to “celebrate our coastline”. Participating communities will be invited to make a pledge for climate action to protect our coastlines for future generations.

Beach of Dreams is working with artists and communities in Wales, England, Scotland and Ireland, to encourage people to celebrate and explore what makes their local coastal landscapes special.

Here in Wales, Beach of Dreams is working with Conwy County, and Abergele is one of five towns taking part!

In May 2025, the Beach of Dreams team will invite communities to “walk the coast” together, carrying one-of-a-kind natural silk pennants, to raise awareness of climate change. Beach of Dreams’ resident artists will create the Abergele pennant on our behalf, but they need our help! The artists would like to know **what makes our stretch of coast so special**, so they can use this as the inspiration for the pennant design.

Beach of Dreams is also bringing sound artist Jason Singh to Conwy County to explore our natural environment in terms of sounds, including those sounds that we cannot hear! Jason, whose soundscapes have featured on television worldwide, will be using specialised equipment to record the sounds of nature in our local environment, and creating a soundtrack of our region.
