

Fly-tipping Action Wales runs the "Eich Dyletswydd Chi yw Gofalu" | "It's Your Duty to Care" campaign.

"It's Your Duty to Care", in partnership with Welsh Government, aims to raise awareness about individuals posing as licenced waste removal services, and urges householders in to ensure that *before* they employ a waste removal service, they check that the company has a licence.

It is important to do this check, because currently, over 70% of fly-tipped waste contains household items! Additionally, Householders must follow the Household Duty of Care, and can be fined £300 and risk prosecution, if they have not done so. Fly-tipping Action Wales has put together some helpful tips on their website – for example, did you know that a contractor must have a waste removal licence beginning with the letters "CBDU" and ending with 1 to 6 numbers?
